

MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

One of the the following requirements is necessary for membership and to participate in Play Days. You must have a **Membership** at Greate Bay Country Club any membership other than social and/or:

- a. Presentation of a valid USGA Handicap Index, which produces a Greate Bay handicap of 39 or less
- b. A copy of the player's last 10 to 20 scores resulting in an index, which produces a Greate Bay handicap of 39 or less. The player's former club professional must attest to these scores.
- c. **Five** adjusted 18 hole, or 9 hole scores resulting in an index, which produces a Greate Bay handicap of 39 or less. These scores must be attested to, dated within 9 months of presentation and turned in to the Pro Shop. Reference the USGA Handicap Manual Section 3-1.

(Use the Spring to get your scores in!)

Membership dues are **\$60 or \$74**(for weekly chip-ins) and are paid annually

PLAY DAYS

- Play days are generally defined as a Tuesday play date.
- 18 holers at 8:15 and 9 holers 9:30am.
- Upcoming play day sign up schedules are listed on the website at www.greatebay.com (click on Tournaments) where you can pick and choose your playing schedule. Online sign up is available four weeks in advance. We will again be using **Signup Genius**. If you are not able to sign up online, please call our Tournament Chair for availability.
- If you cannot play the day you are scheduled, please cancel as soon as you can. There are others that may be able to fill your place, and your tee time partners will not have to play with one less player for that day. You can **cancel online through Sunday** evening before the Tuesday play day. After that, please make a phone call to the Tournament Director. If you cannot reach her, please call the pro shop.
- Each play day has a different format that will be made available to each participant before the beginning of play. There is an optional \$1.00 'chip in' box. If you chip in off of the green during that day's play, you win the pot. However, there may be more than one person who chips in. If this happens, the pot is split.
- You will be responsible for signing and attesting your scorecard and turning it in at the end of play in the lunchroom to the Greate Bay Assistant Pro.

- Please enter your score in the pro shop ASAP! You can also enter on line.
- Also, at the end of the play day, there will be tallying sheets for that day's tournament in the ladies locker room. There is always someone there to help you fill out the sheets correctly.
- Most of the playing field that day stays for lunch in the dining room, Please join us.
